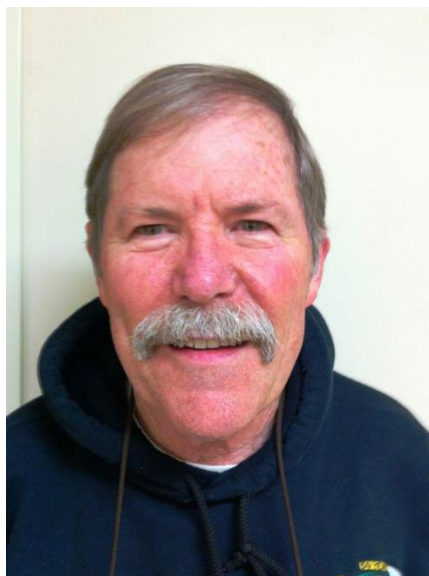


MEMBER SPOTLIGHT
